Tournament Rules and Regulation

- 1. All participants must be a member in good standing with USBC.
- 2. Entry form must be completed, and full entry fees paid. Entry fees are non-refundable. Late entries will be accepted if space is available.
- 3. Entries are taken on a first come basis.
- 4. Entering average shall be determined as follows (all averages will be confirmed):
 - A. The USBC highest average of twenty-one (21) games or more in the 2024-2025 winter season.
 - B. If no 2024-2025 winter average, the USBC highest 2025 summer average may be used.
 - C. If A or B above do not apply, the bowler will use their highest twenty-one (21) games or more current average at the time of participation. (Written verification will be required).
 - D. If the bowler does not come under any of the above categories, the bowler shall bowl scratch (220 avg).
- 5. Bowlers will be responsible for obtaining the average verification, if needed, and will be responsible for bringing verification to the tournament. Bowlers are responsible for verifying their high USBC average. It is the bowler's responsibility to obtain written verification of their average from the Association Manager of the association where it was established and provide it to the tournament director. An entering average 10 pins or more from a current average will be rerated per USBC rules. (USBC Rule 319-C & 319-E will apply)
- 6. Doubles is 2 members.
- 7. All rules not covered by these rules will be covered by USBC rules.
